## RULES

- Mix up the object cards.
- Give each person one card in turn.
- Each player looks to see if he / she can make a group.
- If you can make a group, put the group down on the table.
- The youngest player starts.
- The first player chooses one of the players and chooses one of the objects he / she needs and asks for it
- If the other player has the object card, he / she gives it them. The first player can now ask another question.
- If the other player doesn't have the object card, the turn passes to the next person.
- You can only ask for an object if you have one of that group.
- The winner is the person with the most groups.
